

TNC Training & Match Kit Policy

Purpose

This policy ensures all players wear appropriate clothing for training and matches, supporting safety, comfort, respect, and professionalism, and preventing injury/illness.

General Principles

- Clothing must be comfortable, safe, and suitable for active participation.
- Attire must allow for free movement while maintaining appropriate coverage.
- Clothing should reflect respect for self, teammates, coaches, and the sport.

Training Kit



- Top: TNC Club T-shirt (sports top or t-shirt if you don't yet have club top)
- Bottoms: Leggings, netball skirts with integrated shorts, or training shorts of mid thigh length
- Footwear: Netball or sports trainers that are supportive and non-marking (black soles that could leave marks on indoor courts).

Match Kit

- Netball dresses or Club t-Shirt and shorts/ leggings with netball/ sports trainers
- Additional Items: Base layers or sports jackets in cold weather (to be removed during play if advised by the coach)

Unacceptable Clothing

- Short shorts or excessively revealing clothing.
- Denim, school uniform, or everyday fashion clothing.
- Unsuitable footwear such as hi-top / converse / air force trainers, sandals/crocs, plimsolls, or bare feet.
- Jewellery

Safeguarding and Respect

- Players must change into sportswear before training or matches.
- Clothing choices should prioritise safety, modesty, and inclusivity.
- Coaches reserve the right to ask a player to change if clothing is deemed inappropriate.

Compliance

- Players and parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring correct kit is worn.
- Repeated failure to follow this policy may result in restricted participation until compliance is achieved.
